COVID-19 VACCINATION AND INFLUENZA VACCINATION CLINICS

As advised in our latest COVID-19 update, St Louis Estate, working with GPs on Bayview are seeking approval to host an on-site COVID-19 Vaccination Clinic as soon as possible. We will be included in the 1b rollout and hope to assist all residents in accessing the vaccine on-site. If you would like to receive the vaccine here, please ensure you have registered your interest with reception ASAP.

Once we have more clarity around potential dates for the COVID-19 Vaccination Clinic, we will seek to book in our Annual Influenza Vaccine Clinic which will be held a minimum of 14 days before or after the COVID-19 vaccinations.

All residents are welcomed to receive their free vaccines on-site, however if you would prefer or have any concerns relating to the vaccination programs, we encourage you to consult with and organise your vaccinations directly with your GP.

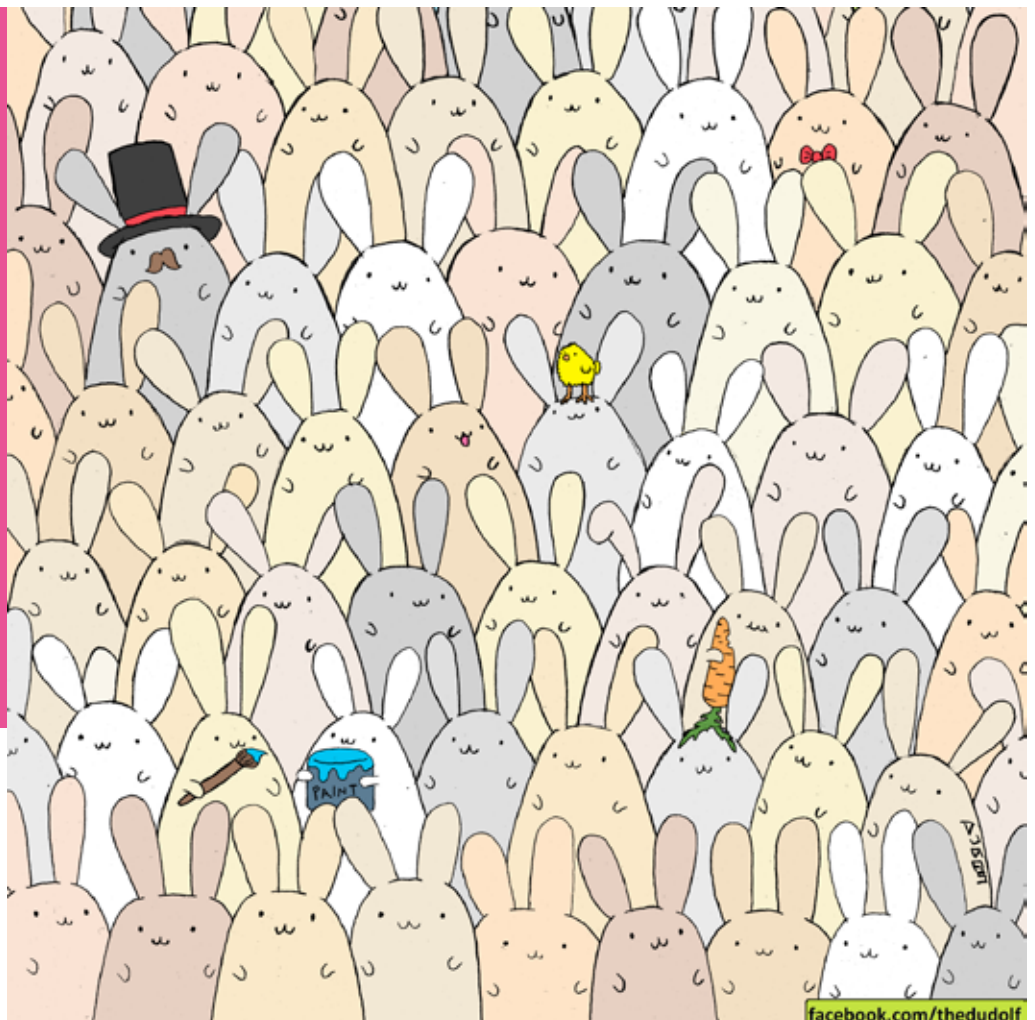
