Roses have been depicted as far back as three and a half thousand years through frescos, archaeological digs, old coins and many other artifacts. No flower has ever featured more prominently than the rose in art or received more attention from poets. The rose has many symbolic links and throughout the twentieth century, we probably didn't think a garden was complete without at least one rose bush. The fragrance of the rose is so powerful that we often tend to put our nose to any rose in bloom, perhaps seeking at least some perfume. Ailsa Allen will take residents on a trip down memory lane highlighting how we have had so much pleasure from roses in Perth, whether in private gardens, public gardens or areas of remembrance.

## THE THAI CAVE RESCUE WITH CRAIG CHALLEN

Wednesday 15th December 2:15pm

We are very privileged and excited to have Dr Craig Challen join us for a special guest talk in December. Afternoon tea will be served prior to the presentation.

Dr Challen SC OAM is an Australian technical diver and cave explorer. He was the recipient of the Oztek 2009 Diver of the Year award for his services to caving, and was joint winner of the 2019 Australian of the Year and 2019 Western Australian of the Year.

He grew up in the Perth suburb of Thornlie and later on farming property in Gidgegannup. A veterinary surgeon by profession, he has made notable dives in Cocklebidy Cave and Pearse Resurgence.

In 2018, Challen and his dive partner Richard Harris were involved in a cave rescue operation in Thailand to evacuate 12 children and an adult from the flooded Tham Luang Cave system.
